ORDINANCES TO BE AWARE OF...

Ordinance #2.02 - A **\$500** fine will be given to any resident that neglects to remove brush, weeds higher than 18", dead or dying trees, filth, garbage, trash, debris, or vehicles/vehicle parts.

Ordinance #2023 - A **\$50** fine will be given to any owner, who's building or occupied lot does not display or properly display the designated official property address of such building/occupied lot.

Ordinance #2022-06 - A **\$500** fine will be given to any property owner that allows a travel trailer or recreational vehicle to become occupied without a special use permit from the Zoning Officer.

For Your Information - In order to conduct a yard sale, you must first acquire a yard sale permit through the Township Zoning Officer. Conducting an unpermitted yard sale will result in fines.
