Liz Cowley of Fortescue asked for a brief explanation of the funding of each phase of the project. Mr. Fleishman stated the project will be constructed in two phases. Phase 1 is the treatment plant and sewer laterals located in Fortescue. Phase 2 is a pump station and pumps for Gandy Beach. He explained all the different funding sources. He reported the project total is \$33M of which 70% is grant funded. The debt for the project will be paid over 40 years at a fee of \$1300 per year per user, which is a worst case estimate. The township is continuing to search for additional funding to help reduce the cost to the end user. The township officials have done a tremendous job of securing this amount of funding.

Robert Biggins of Fortescue asked for the estimated completion date of the project. Mayor Rothman answered June 2026.
