RESOLUTION APPOINTING ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF DOWNE

WHEREAS, there exists a need to contract for Animal Control Services for the Township of Downe, County of Cumberland, and State of New Jersey, for the year 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Downe desires to contract with Countywide Animal Care and Control, LLC for the purposes of providing the services of Animal Control Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Township shall pay the Animal Control Officer, Countywide Animal Care and Control, LLC \$3,600.00 payable at the rate of \$300.00 per month based on 40 service calls, after which the rate will be \$100.00 per call in addition to the monthly fee; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq.) requires that a Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services" and that the Contract be made available for public inspection:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Downe, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Downe Township Committee hereby authorizes the Mayor and Acting Clerk to execute a form of Agreement with Countywide Animal Care and Control, LLC of 4386 Harding Highway, Newfield, NJ 08344, for a period of one (1) year beginning January 9, 2017 through the date of Reorganization 2018 as Animal Control Officer.
- 2. That the Township of Downe agrees to the sum of \$3,600 payable at the rate of \$300 per month based on 40 service calls, after which the rate will be \$100 per call in addition to the monthly fee to the Animal Control Officer for services rendered to the Township of Downe.
- 3. The contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "professional service" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 (1) (a) (i) of the Local Public Contracts Law because the services of the provider are specialized and extensive training and certification are required to satisfactorily provide such services.
- 4. A notice of this action shall be published one time in an official newspaper of the Township of Downe in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i).
