**RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF TEMPORARY WORK AREA
EASEMENT FOR MONEY ISLAND**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee act on behalf of Downe Township in seeking to best implement steps to benefit residents; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey is proposing a project entitled the "Money Island Debris Removal Project" which entails removal of all existing non-natural debris along approximately 1,300 linear feet of shoreline adjacent to Bayview Road in the Money Island portion of the Township; and


WHEREAS, as part of this project, the State of New Jersey requires the Township to enter into a Temporary Work Area Easement; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to enter in to an easement agreement as required by the State of New Jersey, so that the Project may be completed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Downe that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement entitled "TEMPORARY WORK AREA EASEMENT" in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A with the State of New Jersey for the "Money Island Debris Removal Project."
